- 7 If your group is independent of, or a cluster from several schools, please include the above information for *all members*. Using the above template for each member, enter **one person’s** data per field. Then repeat for the next person *Or* Multiple entrants’ doc. format available on website.

Please make information legible, double sided printing is recommended and staple a group’s data together.
